

How to access a personal website directory

To publish a personal website, an FTP account is required.

For information regarding the FTP account, please contact **the administrator of your domain**.

The location where the website will be published is as follows:

http://domain name/~user name

Please use FTPS to upload website data to the server. Due to system specifications, SFTP and SSH connections are not supported.

You can access the directory of your personal website by using FTP client software after configuring “Protocol”, “Encryption”, and other settings as shown below.

When connecting via FTPS, you may see an empty directory, please place files like “index.html” directly in this root directory.
